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# A Message from DCC - Did you know that as well as free school meals during term time, you are also entitled to access FREE holiday clubs this winter holiday?

It's About Me is a **FREE** Holiday Activity and Food Programme funded by the Department for Education, designed for children and young people across Derbyshire to have healthy, active, fun-filled school holidays. We believe that everyone deserves a good break and that school holidays are better when children and young people are active, having fun, being entertained and learning new things.

If your child is aged between 4-16 and is eligible for benefits-related free school meals, then they are entitled to access the It's About Me holiday clubs for free! There are a huge range of activities available including sports and games, arts and crafts, cookery, dance and music. Programmes vary depending on the type and location of each local club and each holiday club will give your child a nutritious meal too!

We hope you will take advantage of these fantastic **FREE** holiday clubs across Derbyshire so your children can have a fun-filled and safe holiday! This Christmas, your local holiday club will be run by Peak Active Sports and be based at Gamesley School so do book a place – we will send the codes out via Dojo this week ready for 4<sup>th</sup> December when bookings open.

#### Can't attend a face-to-face holiday club or unable to find something suitable in your area?

For families with children who are not able to access face-to-face holiday clubs, activity packs and food boxes are also available for the winter school holidays.

#### **Winter Food Boxes**

This winter we are working with Morrison's to offer FREE recipe food boxes. One food box is available for each eligible household (not one per child). Eligible households must have at least one child or young person eligible for benefits-related free school meals living there. You will need your code to request a free winter food box.

#### **Activity Packs**

Activity packs are also available for the winter school holiday; packs are available one per eligible child and are available for Primary or Secondary age. You will need your code to request free winter activity packs. Families can register for a free winter activity pack and/food box from **Monday 27**<sup>th</sup> **November 2023**; registrations close on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2023 or as soon as all activity packs and food boxes have been allocated. #### Booked but can't attend?



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During our summer programme, we had a large numbers of spaces that were booked but the child did not attend.
