Attendance Reminders

Just a reminder that the school gates open at 8.40am each morning and that we expect all children to be settled into their classrooms ready to learn by 8.45am.

If your child is not coming to school for any reason, please do call and leave a message on our absence line to let us know as early as possible. Staff spend a lot of time each morning checking on children who have not arrived and it really helps us if we have heard from you in advance

If we don't have a message from you, we will give you a ring to check that everything is alright and if we cannot contact you, a member of staff will call at your house. This applies to all children including those in Nursery and Reception. Even if your child is not yet of statutory school age, we worry if they have not arrived and we have not heard from you. Please don't be offended if we call round at your house—it is part of our safeguarding duties to ensure that we know where all our children are each day we are expecting them in school.

Arrangements for Dropping Children Off in the Mornings

Please can we ask that (other than Orchard) all children from reception upwards walk into school independently from January? I am also happy for Nursery Conkers children to walk in on their own once you feel they are ready to do so.

It is much easier for staff to monitor children when the playground is uncrowded and clear and therefore also safer for the children. It is also hard for those families who are encouraging their children to walk in their own if other children have their adults with them.

Ms. Sutherland or I will always aim to be on the gate each morning to support your children. Thank you everyone!

Teaching Workshops

Although we try to give you lots of glimpses of what happens in school through our frequent Facebook posts and invitations to performances, lunches etc, we are still trying to find more ways to help you get



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involved with your child's learning. So, starting in the new year, each teacher will be offering termly parent workshops where you can come into the classroom and take part in a lesson.

Places will be limited so as not to overwhelm the children (and staff!) and must be booked in advance. The first couple of dates are outlined below and will be added to over the next few weeks. 
