### Children's Mental Health Week: Monday 5th February 2024

"My Voice Matters"

This year, Children's Mental Health Week wants to empower children of all ages, backgrounds and abilities to work together to create a positive change for their mental health and wellbeing. We want all children and young people to be able to say — and believe - "My Voice Matters." Our staff have been learning about the importance of really listening carefully to children and demonstrating curiosity and empathy, rather than trying to "fix" everything straight away.

We will be talking to the children about the importance of their own voices in Monday's assembly and in lessons next week, and then sharing our learning in a special assembly on Friday.

Your child will also bring home a leaflet and worksheet from "The Worry Wizard", which we use in school, which includes lots of tips about how you can listen to your child and enable them to share any worries they may have.

### **Community Links**

Gamesley School has always prided itself as being at the heart of the local community. We are very pleased that we are developing close links with Robinwood lodge. Our Year 3 Holly Class children are about to begin a reminiscing project with the residents, visiting them each fortnight and finding out more about their memories of life in Gamesley in the past. Year 1 Silver Birch Class are also getting involved and will be at Robinwood next Friday to spend an afternoon playing games and taking part in intergenerational activities there.

We are also very proud indeed of our Year 5 Elm Class children, who spend time each Friday afternoon as "Mini Police" volunteering in the community and finding out more about the work of the police.

We will be taking part in the Willow Wood Bunny Hop again this year. We will share more details and send sponsor forms home after the half term break.





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#### **Arriving at School in the Mornings**

I know that some of you have an arrangement with us to use the front door in the mornings and it's absolutely fine for this to continue.

However, we are currently dealing with a large number of children regularly arriving late each morning. This means that staff are having to leave their classes or their work in the office and walk them through school, which in turn disturbs the classrooms. We get straight down to learning each morning at Gamesley, and by 8.45am the classes are up and running and staff are working with small groups in the bays.

Of course, we understand that there will be times when mornings are very busy and you arrive a few minutes late, so please don't worry if this happens. But it would really help the school to get off to a calm, smooth and productive start each morning if you could bring your children though the main gates if at all possible, and if you do need to use the front door for any reason, that you aim to arrive at 8.40am and certainly no later than 8.45am when the registers open.
