#### 1. Water Bottles

Now that the weather is (finally) getting warmer it is really important that the children can drink water throughout the day. Please check that your child has a school water bottle in school each day. We sell them for just £1.00 each and they can be ordered via Parent Pay.

#### 2. Headlice

We have had a few instances of headlice in both schools recently. Please don't be offended if we give you a call to let you know that we have spotted some little visitors in your child's hair. If you can comb live lice out as soon as you see them with a nit comb and plenty of conditioner you may have a chance to prevent them from laying their eggs (nits) which are much harder to remove as they stick to the hair shafts.


