Dear Families,

1. Dressing for summer in school

Please always send your child to school with a light weight waterproof jacket – preferably with a hood – every day during the summer term. We will be playing out in all weathers if at all possible unless it is exceptionally wet!



In the warmer weather, the children tend to take off coats, jumpers etc when they are playing and abandon them on the field! Do make sure everything is clearly named so we can reunite clothing with the correct owners.

Although we haven't seen much sunshine so far, we are still hoping for warmer weather. Children are encouraged to wear sunhats when they play out. Again, please label them clearly.

2. School Trips

We are very aware that school trips are becoming increasingly expensive. This is partly due to the fact that we are often booking them for single rather than double classes in Key Stage 2, so the cost of hiring a coach is being split between fewer families.

However, we are also committed to giving the children as wide a range of experiences as possible. Our plan going forward is to develop a rolling programme of shared trips to make them as affordable as possible for everyone and we will be sharing the autumn term visits with you as soon as possible to help you to budget.

In the meantime, we have some good news about the upcoming Year 1 and 2 trip to Chatsworth Park on **Thursday 6**th **June**. Mrs McEwan has made a successful bid for a £500 charity grant from the Chatsworth Estate, which means we will be offering families who have already made their full contribution either a refund or the opportunity to transfer this money to the visit to Lytham St. Anne's which is on **Tuesday 9**th **July**.

We are also aware that the planned Year 4 trip to play with the Halle Orchestra on **Tuesday 18th June** was quite expensive for some of our families. We have therefore decided to travel on the school minibus instead to save on the cost of the coach. Unfortunately, this means that this visit will only be open to a limited number of children and will be offered on a "first come" basis. If you have already booked and paid your contribution, your child's place is secured as long as you make the new reduce contribution of £8.00. A letter with more details has been set to our Year 4 families.
